**ANNEXES I, II and III PURSUANT TO MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR NO. 8  
s. 2003 and DA AO NO. 8, s. 2002**

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Pursuant to DA Administrative Order No. 8, s.2002 "Rules and Regulations on the Importation and Release Into The Environment of Plants and Plant Products Derived From The Use of Modern Biotechnology" and DA Memorandum Circular No. 8,s.2003 "Guidelines for the Phytosanitary Inspection of Regulated Articles for Food, Feed and Processing", I am authorizing the release of the following Annexes:

**ANNEX I: APPROVAL REGISTRY FOR THE IMPORTATION OF  
REGULATED ARTICLES FOR DIRECT USE FOR FOOD, FEED OR  
PROCESSING**

Annex I is the initial list of approved GM plant products in the country, and which shall form part of the "Approval Registry for Direct Use For Food, Feed or Processing" (the Annex I List). It is based on the technical recommendations of the DA regulatory agencies led by the Bureau of Plant Industry (BPI) and the Scientific and Technical Review Panel (STRP).

All plant products in the Annex I List have undergone the approval process required by AO 8, including a satisfactory risk assessment conducted by DA regulatory agencies and the STRP. The plant products in the Annex I List will be allowed entry if accompanied by the usual BPI/BAI import permit and/or phytosanitary permit. Pursuant to Section 12 H of AO 8, a notification shall be submitted to the BPI within 15 days from arrival of the shipment. Pursuant to Section II of MC 8, a Declaration of GMO content will be submitted to the Bureau of Plant Industry, upon arrival of the shipment.

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**ANNEX II. APPROVAL REGISTRY OF REGULATED ARTICLES FOR PROPAGATION, FOR WHICH ITS PLANT PRODUCTS HAVE BEEN APPROVED FOR DIRECT USE AS FOOD, FEED, AND/OR PROCESSING**

Annex II is the list of plants which have been approved for local propagation in accordance with AO 8 and have undergone the phase-by-phase, step-by-step risk assessment: from contained use under the supervision of the National Committee on Biosafety of the Philippines (NCBP); to field tests under the supervision of NCBP or DA, as the case may be; and propagation under the DA.

These plant products have undergone satisfactory food, feed and environmental safety assessment mandated under AO 8 when they were evaluated for propagation.

Plant products listed in the Annex II List shall be entered by the Bureau of Plant Industry into ANNEX I List as they are likewise approved for direct use as food, feed, and/or processing.

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**ANNEX III. LIST OF REGULATED ARTICLES FOR IMPORTATION FOR DIRECT USE REQUIRING A DECLARATION OF GMO CONTENT**

The Bureau of Plant Industry shall also maintain a list of regulated articles for direct use consisting of all commercialized GM plant products (the "Annex III List").

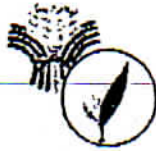
All plant products in Annex III List are those that : (1) have a genetically engineered counterpart, which has been commercialized or released into the market); (2) are in primary/natural state or semi-processed form; and (3) require an import permit and/or phytosanitary certificate.

All plant products the Annex III List shall be required to be accompanied by a Declaration of GMO Content which shall be submitted to the Plant Quarantine Service of the Bureau of Plant Industry, upon the arrival of such shipment. Those with a Declaration of non-GMO content will be allowed entry. For those with a positive GMO declaration, they must also be in Annex I List before they are allowed entry.

All the above-mentioned registries (i.e., Annex I List, Annex II List and Annex III List) shall be updated, as necessary, by the Bureau of Plant Industry.


