Terms of Reference:

1. Assist the Biotech Core Team and its sub-units in day-to-day operations;
2. Process GM application and conduct evaluation for its completeness and sufficiency;
3. Prepare and consolidate the risk assessment reports of agencies document reports and proposals relevant to biotechnology;
4. Prepare office memoranda and letters;
5. Provide support in the conduct of seminars, workshops, training, and other activities;
6. Formulate and maintain a records management system in the implementation of the revised JDC No.1 s2021 and DA MC No. 8 s2022;
7. Provide frontline services for the processing of applications for field trials, commercial propagation, direct use permits, request for technical consultation, evaluation and determination;
8. Open an application file for all biosafety permit applications;
9. Keep updated its Approval Registries;
10. Provide technical and administrative assistance to the Joint Assessment Group;
11. Prepare the consolidated report on the Public Information Sheet;
12. Announce at its website all applications and biosafety permits issued;
13. Document the discussions of the JAG during its meetings and assist in the preparation of the recommendation document for the BPI Director;
14. Provide support and technical assistance in monitoring compliance to biosafety conditions; and
15. Perform other relevant functions.

As such, the Biotechnology Core Team shall perform all the duties and responsibilities inherent to their respective designation in addition to their present workload.

All officials and employees of the Bureau of Plant Industry are hereby enjoined to give their full support and cooperation to the members of the Biotechnology Core Team.

This Order shall take effect immediately and shall supersede all other Orders inconsistent herewith.
