10. Provide technical and administrative assistance to the Joint Assessment Group.
11. Prepare the consolidated report on the Public Information Sheet.
12. Announce at its website all applications and biosafety permits issued.
13. Document the discussions of the JAG during its meetings and assist in the preparation of the recommendation document for the BPI Director.
14. Perform other relevant functions

As such, the Biotechnology Core Team shall perform all the duties and responsibilities inherent to their respective designation in addition to their present workload.
